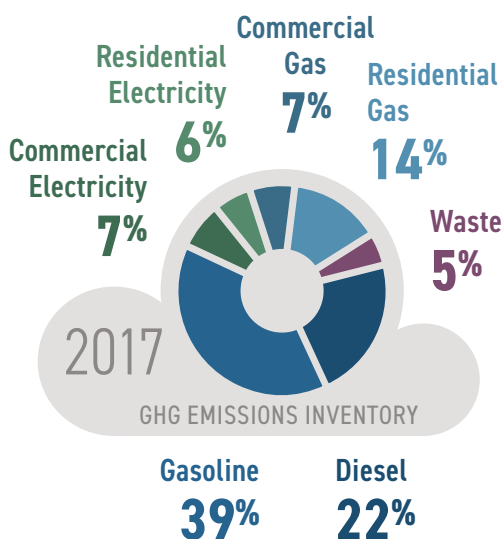
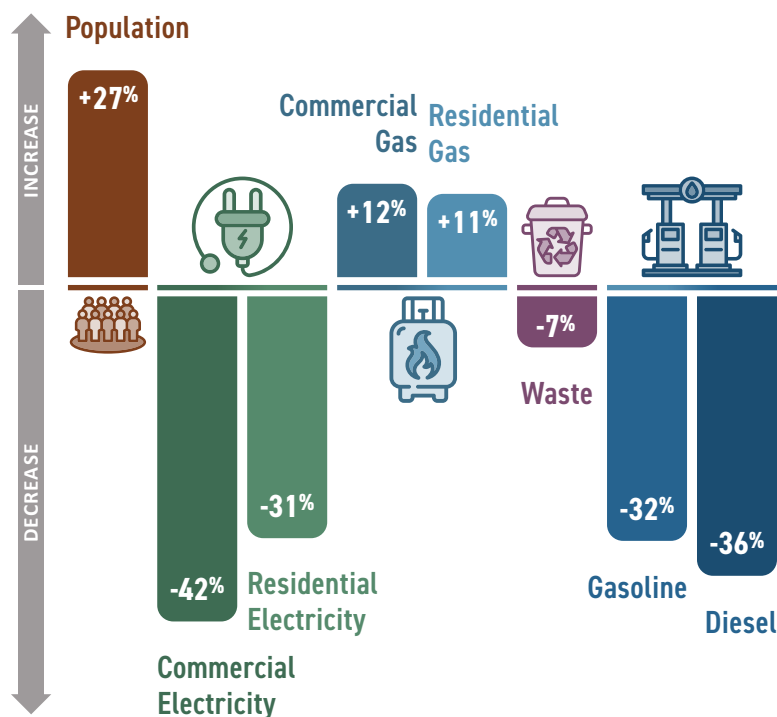


GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS

Chico has completed a GHG inventory for each year between 2005 and 2017. The pie chart below shows the breakdown of GHG emissions in 2017. The largest emission sources include natural gas, transportation fuels, and electricity consumption.



Since 2005, emissions in Chico have decreased **27% overall** and **42% per person**, despite a large population increase.



Chico has already met its 2020 Climate Action Plan Emissions Goal to decrease emissions 25% below 2005 levels. Emissions are expected to continue decreasing through 2045 due to State-level regulations. The City of Chico will meet or exceed State goals to reduce emissions further: **40% below 1990 levels by 2030 and net zero by 2045.**
